

Case Study Guidelines

Ergonomics – Design Principles and Applications for Engineers

Please refer to the step-by-step guidelines below to develop and present your ergonomics Case Study. An example Case Study is available for review.

Step One – Delineate Case Study Groups

Course attendees will form Project Groups (with assistance from the Course Facilitators)

- Group size will be between 3 and 5 members
- We anticipate about 7 to 8 groups
- Group composition will be via work areas and geographic locations (MN and CA)

Step Two - Choose Case Study Project

Two options are available to choose your group's Case Study. The case studies are intended to be focused on a specific task issue as compared to an entire process.

Option One – Choose Pre-determined Project

- About five case study projects with video are available to select from
- Up to three groups can choose the same project, we think this will lead to some interesting discussions as different groups may view the same project differently with different recommendations

Option Two – Group chooses specific Project

- Group chooses a project unique to their area of interest
- This could be an existing ergonomics issue or a potential issue
- The group will need to obtain descriptive video of the project

Step Three - Perform the Case Study

- 1. Using the *Workstation Ergonomics Design Worksheet* and *Engineering Ergonomics Reference Guide* select and fill out the Checklists pertinent to your project (refer to the Example Case Study)
- 2. Analyze your findings
- 3. Fill out the Workstation Configuration Worksheet to document your results
- 4. We appreciate in the time frames of the course; you may not be actually implementing the proposed interventions but will be able to postulate the recommendations

Step Four – Prepare your Group Case Study Presentation

Each group will prepare their case study for presentation during the debriefing session.

- 1. Identify the *Checklists, Specifications* and *Guidelines* you referenced
- 2. Prepare your findings via the **Workstation Configuration Worksheet** and other information you deem necessary

Step Five – Present and discuss your Case Study (7 to 10 minutes allocated)

- 1. Introduce your case study by showing your video
- 2. Present your Case Study Project findings to the group
- 3. Course instructor will facilitate discussion
