- 1. Position blue carts and pallet jacks at Packing workstations
  - Hook up blue cart to EZ-GO
  - Use handheld scanner
  - Drive EZ-GO to position the blue cart at the Packing workstation
  - Disconnect EZ-GO from blue cart
  - Hook up pallet jack to EZ-GO
  - Drive EZ-GO to position pallet jack at various locations at the Packing workstations
  - Disconnect EZ-GO from the pallet jack









#### 2. Use manual pallet jack to move pallets
