Functional Job Elements

% of Shift

1. Hook up EZ-GO to cart

- Drives EZ-GO to connect to the cart.
- May push/pull empty cart if needed. (up to 25# of push/pull force).





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2. Maneuver EZ-GO and cart through warehouse to pick product

- Driving EZ-GO and pulling cart picks nonconvey product (nonconvey: product because of weight and size cannot be conveyed on the warehouse conveyance system).
- Operates the handheld RDT.
- Loads items from pallets on the floor onto the cart.
- Lifts, pushes and pulls items to load onto the cart.
- To obtain items may reach into the racking to gain access.
- Picks about 12 to 15 items per cart.
- Typical items handled are TVs and rugs.
- Some items may be stacked on the cart up to a height of about 60".
- Weight range: up to 50#, with average of about 25#.

















3. Returns cart to Packing area

 When full cart has been picked returns cart to packing area and disconnects cart from the EZ-GO.






