

Solution Sheet for the Mobile Worker

Laptop/Tablet -	Docking station with external monitor, keyboard and mouse
Single Desk/Table	Adjust like traditional workstation
Laptop/Tablet -	Portable stand
	Travel keyboard (Bluetooth)
Mobile/Tabletops	Bluetooth mouse
(conference rooms,	Adjust chair (or add cushion, when feasible)
hotels, coffee shops)	May also consider Laptop desk for keyboard/mouse while laptop/tablet
	remains on tabletop
	Backpack or rolling bag
Laptop/Tablet -	Laptop desk
	Use predictive text/text replacement/shortcuts to decrease keystrokes
Mobile/No Tabletops	Sit back in chair
(airport, lounge	Limit time in single sitting if unable to be in neutral
chairs, vehicles)	Backpack or rolling bag
Tablet/Smartphone –	Use headset
	Smaller device: Pop socket
Holding device while	Larger device: g-hold microsuction, LoveHandle tablet grip, hand straps
using	Use digital assistant, speaker, dictation, predictive text, text replacement

	○ iPhone – Settings → Keyboards → Text replacement, one-handed

Save a few clicks with	Hide Row = [Ctrl] 9

Shortcuts	Copy from cell above = [Ctrl] ' (apostrophe key)
	Copy formula from cell above = [Ctrl] '
Press and hold [Ctrl]	Copy value from above (not formula) = [Ctrl] [Shift] "
while pressing 2 nd key	Open print preview window = [Ctrl] [F2]
	Move one screen to right = [Alt] [PgDn]
	Move one screen to left = [Alt] [PgUp]
	Move one tab (sheet) to right = [Ctrl] [Alt] [PgDn]
	Move one tab (sheet) to left = [Ctrl] [Alt] [PgUp]
